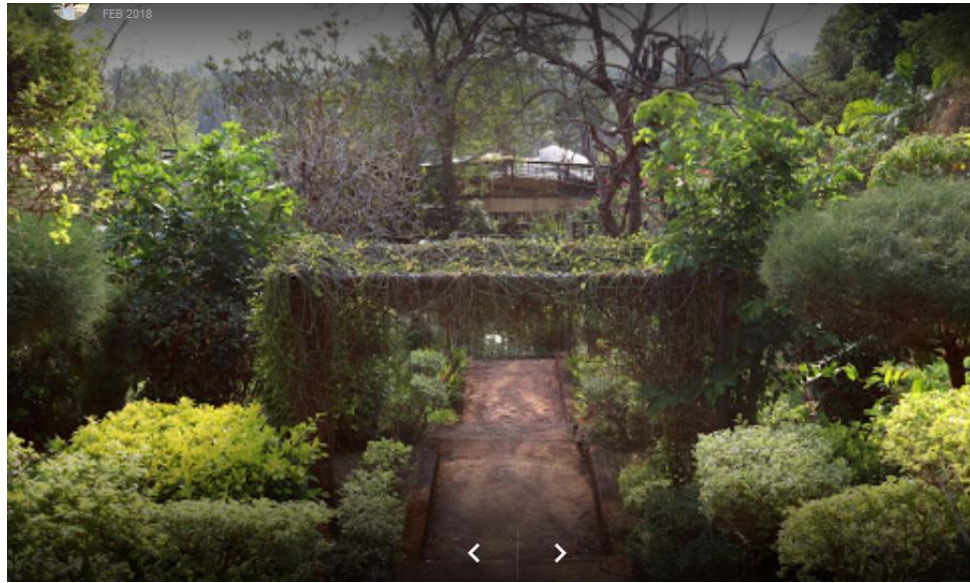

Memorandum of Understanding to Establish Technology and Innovation Support Center

Between
National Intellectual Property Office hereinafter referred to as NIPO
And
The University of Kelaniya

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets out the terms and understanding between NIPO and the University of Kelaniya to establish Technology and Innovation Support Center (TISC) at University of Kelaniya.

Background
This program provides innovators with access to local Patent database, high quality technological information and related services via other websites, helping them to exploit their innovative potential and to create, protect, and manage their intellectual property (IP) rights by establishing Technology and Innovation Support Centers in Sri Lanka in collaboration with the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO).

Purpose
This MOU will provide necessary cooperation between NIPO and University of Kelaniya to establish a TISC Center at University of Kelaniya. The aim of this project is to stimulate innovation of the country by providing access to the patent and non patent databases and technological information.

The above goals will be accomplished by establishing a TISC at the University of Kelaniya. The University of Kelaniya will allocate necessary staff and infrastructure (A PC with internet Access) for this project. NIPO will provide necessary training and guidance to such officers in consultation with WIPO.

Reporting
NIPO will evaluate the progress of the project and maintain records on the progress. NIPO will also report the progress of this project to WIPO as scheduled in the project report.

Infrastructure Facility
This project does not involve any financial commitment from NIPO or WIPO. The University of Kelaniya may have the necessary cost/ infrastructure for this project as the beneficiaries of this project are Scientists, Researchers and Inventors of the country.

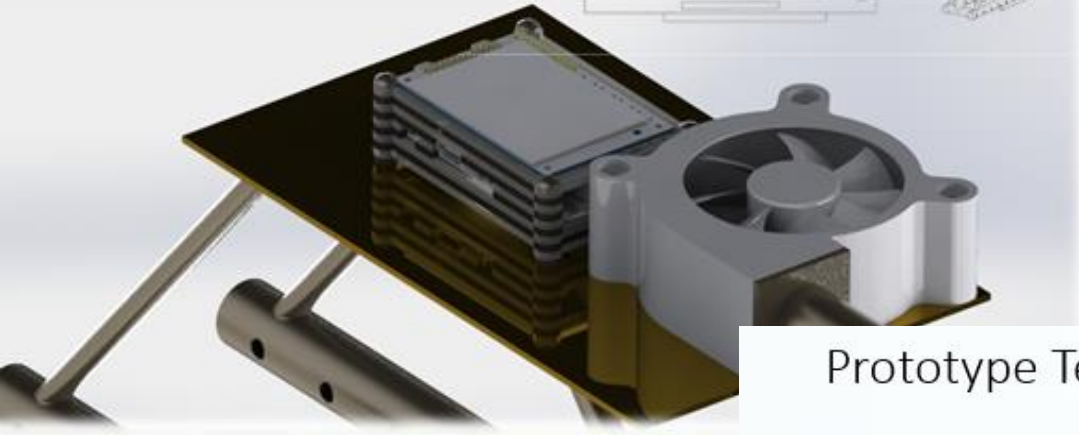
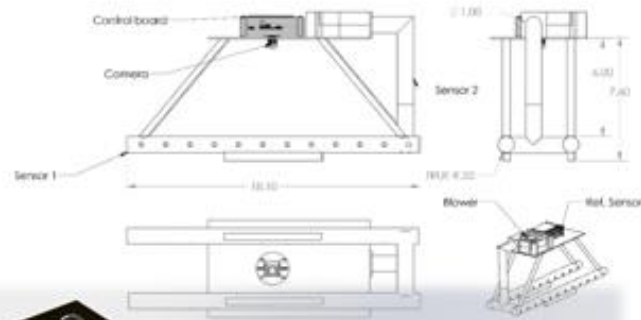
