like networks/databases.

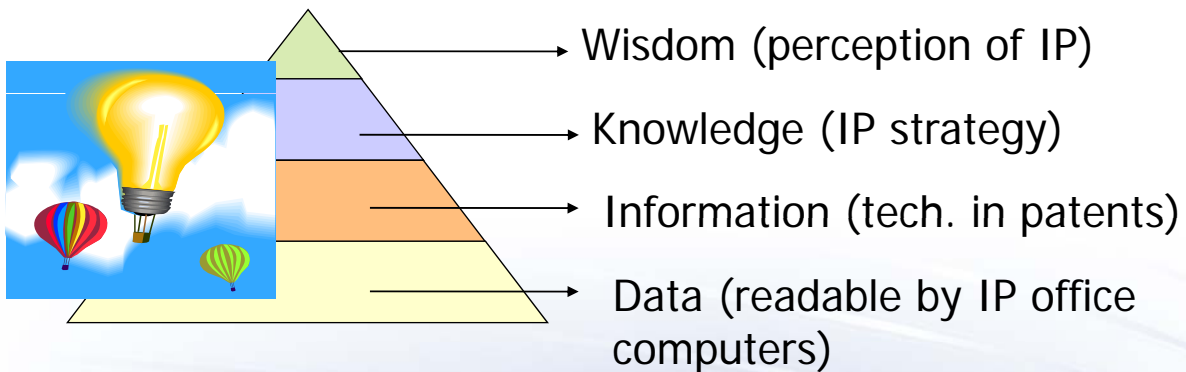

Why IP Knowledge helps innovation and creativity?

- scientists, engineers, business and investors in many countries have limited access to IP knowledge and do not fully participate in global innovation activities
- national IP infrastructure exists without connected globally and blocks the flow of IP knowledge
- Efforts to create a common platform just began
- Global infrastructure needs to be based on common and standardized institutions and tools to make IP knowledge flow
- Fluid IP becomes more important than stock IP

Structure of Infrastructure

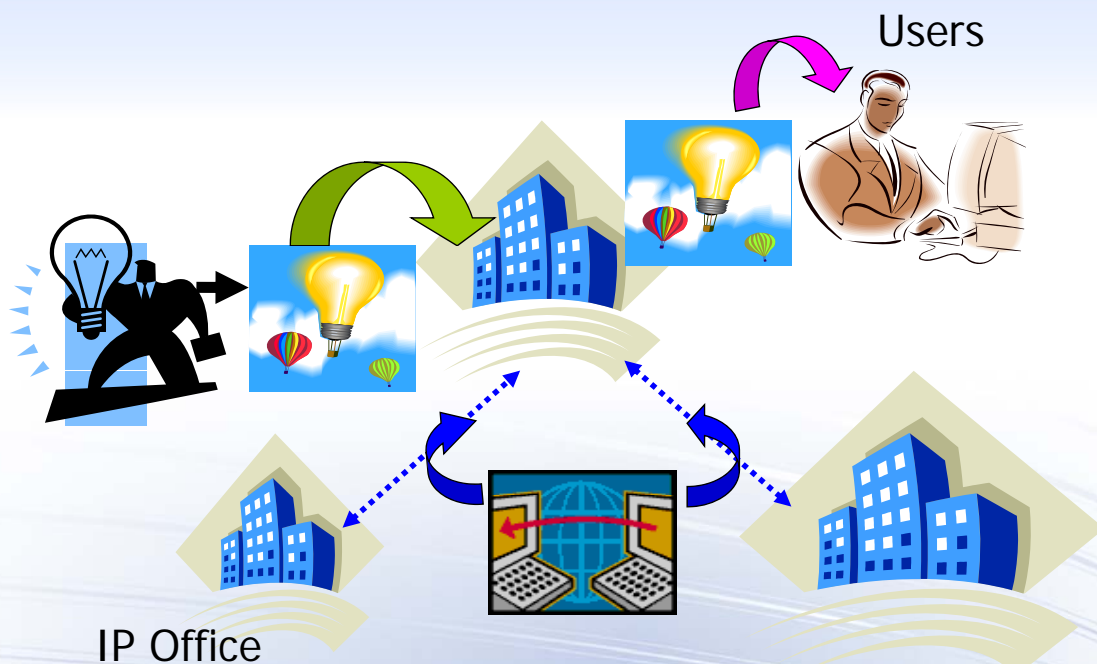

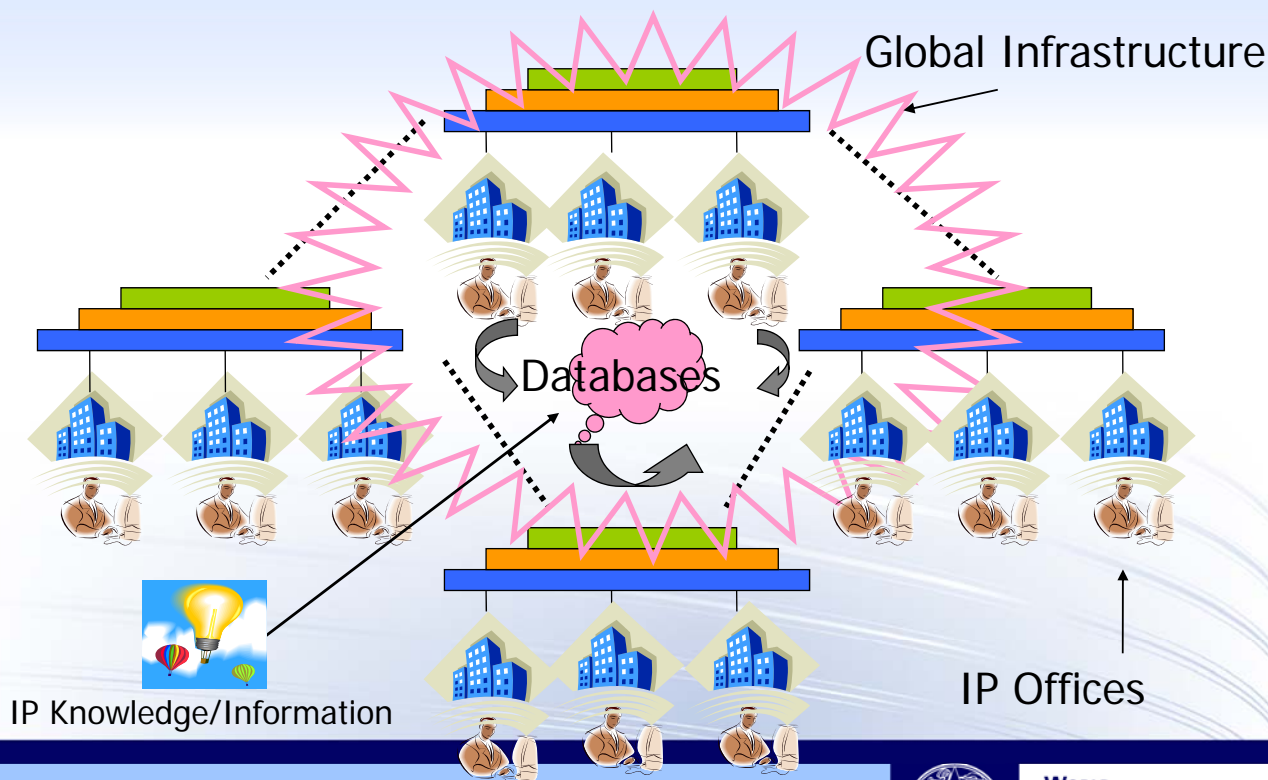

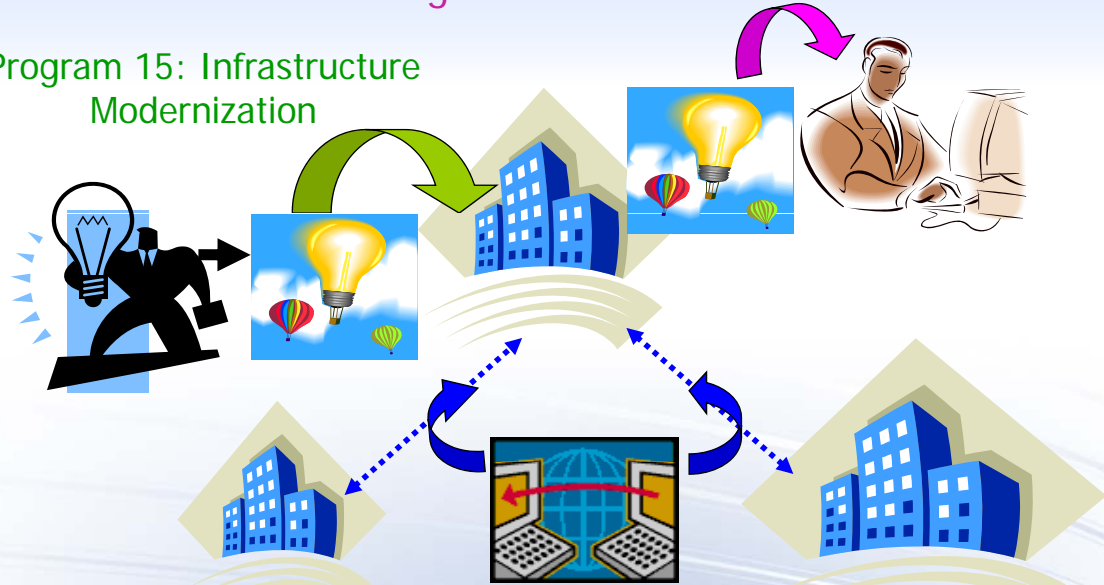
