- WIPO-Sweden Advanced Training Course on Industrial Property in the Global Economy
- WIPO-Sweden Advanced Training Course on Copyright and Related Rights in the Global Economy
- WIPO-Norcode Advanced Training Program on Management of Copyright and Related Rights in the Global Economy

### Main Features / Four phases:

- Preparatory phase (identification of a national project)
- Course in Sweden/Norway
- Implementation of project (home country)
- Follow-up session (developing country)

## Specialized courses

- WIPO-CIPO Executive Workshop on the Application of Management Techniques in the Delivery of IP Services
- WIPO-NIPO Training Course on Patents
- WIPO-NIPO Training Course on Trademarks
- WIPO-OAPI Workshop on IP for Researchers

## Summer School:

- Interdisciplinary
- Same curriculum
- Same teaching methodology:
  - DL 101 integral part of the curriculum
  - Lectures (issues-oriented approach)
  - Simulation exercises
  - Case studies
  - Moot court
  - Group discussions
- Two week course
- Online registration + fee payment
