Background

- Trademark become an important component of trade
- Trademark right acquired protection in a country where it being registered
- Many obstacles for entrepreneurs to register their trademarks in the country of destination of exports

Background…

- provide business owners who seeking international legal protection
- the terms of the partnership agreement with Japan (IJEPA) which was signed in 2007
- the terms of ASEAN Economic Community 2015

Preparation of Indonesia in Acceding to the Madrid Protocol

- Consulting with the expert
- Providing trainings, seminars, workshops
- Proposing revision of Trademark Law
- Ratification

Pros and cons

- Consultants argued that join to the Madrid Protocol will effect in the loss of their clients especially foreign trademark applicant
- handiness and ability of Directorate General of Intellectual Property Rights in implementing the Madrid Protocol system
- negative impact on the ratification of Madrid protocol

Response of DGIPR

- Held the dialogue more active to get more public input and feedback
- Held seminars, trainings, workshops to studying the advantages and disadvantages of joining Madrid Protocol

Current Situation

- Amended Trademark Law and Regulation (on going process)
- change of trademark registration procedure from post grant into pre grant
- Publication period longer than before
- ✓ adopt 3D and sound mark
- add civil and criminal penalties more severe for criminal offenses on trademark which cause a more harmful impact to the public
- simplify the process and procedures for trademark
 registration

Current...

- Preparations related infrastructure
- Development of IT systems
- Develop human resource continuously
