- Multi class
- Madrid Chapter
- Partial assignment
- Late renewal allowed

- Inbound-Outbound clearly defined
- Implementing provisions
- Notification to IB in various cases



### Challenges

- Understanding the Protocols, Regulations and Administrative Instructions
- Definitions used in Madrid differing from the national's ones
- Many national provisions not applied to Madrid
- 3 level of Committees, different opinions (none of them has direct experience !!), different interpretation

- Conservative culture

### Challenges

- Educating IT company on Madrid procedure/work flow (both inbound and outbound)
- Understanding technical terminologies in e-Notif and MECAINT, not enough explanation
- Linking with Main TM which is extremely complicate
- Amount of workload surpass the budget
- Undocumented IT procedure, requiring tele-conference with WIPO for explanation
- Paperless or less paper



### 3. Resource Preparation

#### Staff

- Set up Madrid Group
- Recruit more officers

#### Competency

- Knowledge of the system
- English competency

#### Office

- Dedicated area (separate office)
- Office equipment




### Challenges

- Government policy in general not to increase
- Have to be trained as a national examiner first before doing Madrid
- Deep knowledge of the Madrid system required
- English language capability
- Translation of indications into Thai
- High rate of turnover even before commencing the system
- Backlog

Min. Regulations to be finalized and sent to Cabinet and Council of the State for approval

Prototype of IT system due to complete by this month and be tested in Jan 17

New staff to be trained in Jan 17

Assessment by WIPO in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2017 (hopefully around end of Jan 17)
