 China became party to the Madrid Agreement in 1989 and became a member of the Protocol in 1995. After 27 years' operation of the Madrid system, China has become the most designated contracting party. Last year we got 24849 designations and about 39000 modifications. And the designations have increased year after year.

- Rules for the Implementation of the Madrid System for the International Registration of Marks
- Promulgation in 1996
- New promulgation in 2003
- Abolished





State Administration for Industry & Commerce of the People's Republic of China

- Flexibility of the Madrid System
- Rule 17(5)(e)(ex officio provisional refusal not open to review before the Office)
- Rule 20bis(6)(b)(recording of licenses provided for in the domestic law, but the recording of licenses in the International Register has no effect)
- Gazette and opposition
