

## Geneva Act of the Lisbon Agreement on Appellations of Origin and Geographical Indications

### Ratification by Peru

1. On July 18, 2022, the Government of Peru deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of ratification to the Geneva Act of the Lisbon Agreement on Appellations of Origin and Geographical Indications (hereinafter referred to as “the Geneva Act of the Lisbon Agreement”), adopted in Geneva on May 20, 2015.

2. Pursuant to Rule 4(1) of the Common Regulations under the Lisbon Agreement for the Protection of Appellations of Origin and their International Registration and the Geneva Act of the Lisbon Agreement on Appellations of Origin and their Geographical Indications (hereinafter referred to as “the Common Regulations”), the Government of Peru has notified the following name and contact details of its Competent Authority for the purposes of the procedures provided for by the Geneva Act of the Lisbon Agreement:
